KC Urban Advantage: Field Trips



KC Urban Advantage is a standards-based collaboration between the Museum at Prairiefire, partner schools, and other nonprofit learning institutions, including the Overland Park Arboretum and the National WW1 Museum. Administered by the Museum at Prairiefire, KC Urban Advantage (KCUA) provides access to STEAM learning opportunities to support STEM achievement in underserved schools. The program engages students in STEM exploration and investigation through hands-on experiences.

KCUA bolsters this education by:

- Providing specialized development for teachers to enhance the classroom STEM curriculum.
- Furnishing equipment and supplies for classes
- Providing KCUA schools access to partner institutions in the greater Kansas City metro and urban core
- Offering family activities to support STEM engagement while at home and at school

The broad scope and diversified constituency create a true "urban advantage" for STEM education in the public school system.

<u>Great Hall Scavenger Hunt</u>: students explore artifacts related to our local natural history (20 minutes) <u>Wetlands Trail</u>: guided tour about local ecology when weather permits (20 minutes) <u>Fossil Prep</u>: students experience the thrill of discovery as they extract fossils they keep (45 minutes) <u>Bridge Building</u>: students explore the design process as they engineer a bridge (45 minutes) <u>Animal Presentation</u>: up-close encounters with Discovery Room animals (45 minutes)

Field Trip to Partner Institutions

<u>Overland Park Arboretum Visit:</u> offers the opportunity for students to view and evaluate a wide variety of hybrid trees, shrubs, wildflowers, birds, and animals native to the area.

<u>National WW1 Museum and Memorial:</u> offers students the opportunity to experience the stories, interactive displays, films and eyewitness testimonies one of the largest collections of WWI artifacts in the world.
